



COVID-19 Procedures GVR Clubs

Contact Tracing

If a club member tests positive for COVID-19, please contact the Club President to initiate the COVID protocol.



Club Presidents, upon learning a club member has tested positive, please:

1. Obtain the following information:
 - The member's name
 - The day (or days) they last visited the club space
 - The date they received their positive test results
2. Email the Club Liaison (kathye@gvrec.org)
 - If after hours or on the weekend, call the COA (520-343-2440) to notify them
3. ***For clubs with attendance readers:***
 - GVR will pull the member's attendance records
 - GVR will not share the names of any involved person unless so compelled by health authorities
4. ***For clubs who utilize sign-in sheets:***
 - Please send a copy of the sign-in sheet for the last day the member visited the club space to the Club Liaison
 - GVR may request additional sign-in sheets, if needed
5. The Recreation Department will coordinate with Facilities Maintenance to determine a course of action regarding building and facility closures and/or sanitization, as needed
6. GVR will post reported incidents of a known case of COVID-19 on the GVR COVID-19 page (<https://www.gvrec.org/covid19/>)

When someone tests positive for COVID-19, their test results are shared with public health officials so they can begin a case investigation. An investigator may call the person who tested positive for COVID-19 to collect information about their illness and to discuss anyone they spent time with (their "contacts"). Once a person has identified their contacts, contact tracers will notify contacts of their exposure to COVID-19. Public health case investigators and contact tracers will NEVER release the name of the person who tested positive for COVID-19, or leave a voicemail with sensitive information about exposure to COVID-19.

If you get a call from "AZ HEALTH" (602) 675-8558, or your local health department, PLEASE answer the call. During tracing calls, contacts are asked if they are experiencing any symptoms of COVID-19, and if symptoms are reported, public health will work with the contact on additional follow-up and recommendations.
