



# GVR Pickleball Club Membership Application 2021



There are two ways to join or renew membership with the GVR Pickleball Club.

- 1) Online at <https://gvpc.pickleball.plus/> - preferred method as it is the most secure, reduces paper use and volunteer labor, and processing time is instant.
- 2) Complete this form (processing time can take up to two or more weeks and can delay entry into the system affecting ability to join Club tournaments).

Annual dues are \$15 per person and the term runs from January 1 to December 31. Active members on March 1 are eligible to vote in the club election. New members joining after October 1 will receive credit for the year's remaining months and for the full year beyond.

**Accounts expire December 31 with a renewal grace period thru January 31 and are inaccessible until dues are paid.**

Credit cards (via online system only) and checks or cash (via paper form only) are accepted.

***TIP: username is member's email address and passwords can be regenerated by clicking the Forgot Password button.***

By completing and submitting the information online or below, applicants agree to be part of the club's online, private membership database and to receive club and member communication via email. The database is an essential feature for club members to connect. No information is shared outside of the club.

***The Pickleball.Plus system requires separate forms/accounts for each person and for each field to be populated. If you have only one phone number, please duplicate it.***

# What does the GVR Pickleball Club provide for its members?

## Playing Pickleball

- Provides pickleballs, including replacements when you step on them or wear them out.
- Provides court schedules for the beginner, to recreational, to competitive players.
- Organizes a variety of play formats: focus play, round robins, mixers, challenge, drop-in.
- Via the Club website, allows court reservations at the different locations and times during the week.
- Organizes Club and community tournaments and participation in the TAPPL league during the year.

## Facilities

- Ensures that court maintenance is completed on a regular basis or as needed.
- Working with GVR ensures that court conditions, supplies and amenities are properly cared for, such as first aid supplies, court surface, gates, wind screens, windsocks, court signage, etc.
- Provides sign-in and storage units at the 3 pickleball court locations.
- Provides a TUTOR ball machine with pickleballs, ball totes, etc. available by reservation.
- Hitting wall on court 1 at East Center courts.

## Education

- Serves a coordinating role with GVR to provide a variety of fee based classes for the beginner to the advanced player.
- Provides Developing Skills playing sessions for 2.0/2.5 skill players at no charge.
- Provides training for the TUTOR ball machine.
- Coordinates clinics held by nationally and locally recognized pickleball instructors.

## Player Ratings

- Provides rating evaluation for a member, who wants to test for their next higher skill level.
- Provides support for players who want to prepare for their rating evaluation.

## Social Networking and Club Merchandise

- Hosts Club parties, gatherings, and picnics during the year.
- Sends well wishes sent to members experiencing challenging times.
- Facilitates the purchase and resale of Club shirts, jackets, and name badges.

## Communication

- Develops and maintains a Club website which includes information about the Club & Pickleball in general, and online signups for club events and membership.
- Manages a members only Facebook web page.
- Provides announcements regarding current & upcoming events to members via email, Facebook, and/or the website.
- Occasionally solicits feedback, suggestions regarding various aspects of the Club via email, Facebook, or survey.

## Volunteer Opportunities

- Volunteer for the Club Board, Committee Chairpersons, Committee members.
- Volunteer as coaches for GVR pickleball classes and Developing Skills playing sessions.
- Volunteer to serve in various capacities with the Southern Arizona Senior Games pickleball tournament.

## Community Relations including GVR (Green Valley Recreation)

- Identifies club needs and submits requests to GVR.
- Works with GVR staff on a continual basis to ensure court safety and availability.
- Reports issues to GVR that need attention and/or maintenance.
- Facilitates inter-community play with other local pickleball clubs.
